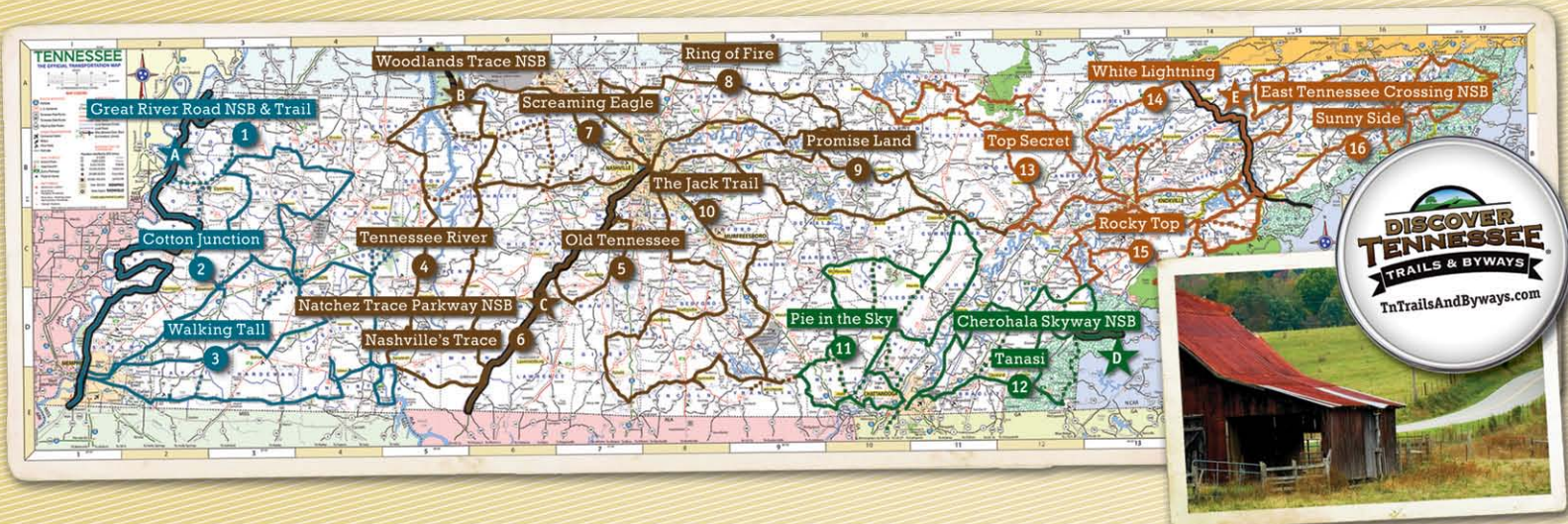

### MEMPHIS



#### Cotton Junction

Take a drive through the fields and small towns of West Tennessee's cotton country, where the blooming crops are breathtaking in late summer.



#### Great River Road National Scenic Byway & Trail

The Tennessee portion of this 10-state byway takes you through some of the most scenic stretches of the Lower Mississippi Valley, from Memphis to amazing Reelfoot Lake.



#### Walking Tall

Head east of Memphis for Civil War history, quaint small towns, beautiful Pickwick Lake and a glimpse into the lives of American legends like Buford Pusser, Carl Perkins and Casey Jones.

### NASHVILLE



#### Nashville's Trace

Travel one of the country's most scenic byways and duck into the unique communities behind the trees for history, adventure, music and a down-home meal or two.



#### Natchez Trace National Scenic Byway

The Trace is a favorite for cyclists, motorcyclists, campers, hikers and Sunday drivers eager to take in the unspoiled beauty of this route, which dates back to prehistoric Native Americans.



#### Old Tennessee

From historic Franklin, visit the area's first settlements, Antebellum mansions, Civil War battlefields and more, all set against a beautiful backdrop of rolling hills.

## NASHVILLE (continued)



### Promised Land

Follow parts of the historic Walton Road stagecoach route and find yourself exploring President Andrew Jackson's home, strolling charming towns and browsing antiques.



### Ring Of Fire

Make this loop through tobacco country to see early settlements, friendly towns and Civil War sites; get to know our farm heritage and explore our legends, from Johnny Cash to the Bell Witch.



### Screaming Eagle

This drive is rich in military history, from the Civil War to today's famed Screaming Eagles 101st Airborne Division. Discover unexpected treasures, like the Woodlands Trace National Scenic Byway, where bison and elk still roam.



### Tennessee River Trail

Explore some of the state's richest and most beautiful river country, book-ended by two state parks and packed with history and outdoor adventure.



### The Jack Trail

Visit three distinctive Tennessee distilleries, learn about the Tennessee Walking Horse and explore history through Civil War battlefields, historic homes and even a working pioneer village.



### Woodlands Trace National Scenic Byway

This easy, beautiful drive between Kentucky Lake and Lake Barkley near Land between the Lakes offers beautiful rolling terrain with outdoor adventure and scenic views.

## CHATTANOOGA



### Cherohala Skyway National Scenic Byway

Drive above the clouds at a 5,400-foot elevation and get a glimpse into the unspoiled environment along the Tellico River.



### Pie In The Sky

Follow this trail from beautiful downtown Chattanooga to iconic tourist spots like Rock City and Ruby Falls, then set off into the Appalachian foothills for outdoor adventure, amazing views, historic sites and all kinds of treats.



### Tanasi

This beautiful, lake-spotted drive is rich in Native American Heritage and outdoor adventure. You'll encounter festivals, museums, quaint towns and plenty to do, on the water or on land.

## KNOXVILLE/GREAT SMOKY MOUNTAINS



### East Tennessee Crossing National Scenic Byway

This byway brings you breathtaking scenery and access to walking trails, historic sites, general stores and restaurants you won't find anywhere else.



### Rocky Top

Take off into the Appalachian landscape of the Smokies, where you'll uncover history, unique crafts communities, the music and thrills of Dollywood and tons of outdoor fun, including Great Smoky Mountains National Park.



### Sunny Side

Visit the place where country music was born as a part of your journey through the quiet back roads of East Tennessee. You'll get a taste of the Smokies, travel through the Cherokee National Forest and find hidden gems in every town along the way.



### Top Secret

Explore the Cumberland Plateau's natural beauty, unique communities and historical significance as you travel to the "Secret City," visit a former utopian community, and marvel at the breathtaking scenery.



### White Lightning

Follow the footsteps of moonshine-running rebels through the hills for a glimpse of Appalachian history and folk life, delivered through music, scenery, crafts and food.

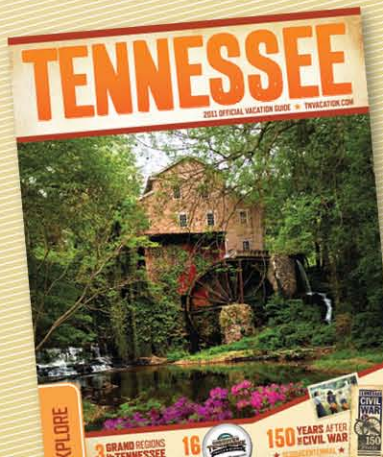
